Grade 5 and 6 created their own version of a Hundertwasser art work. Students were expected to use at least 3 different types of water based medium.

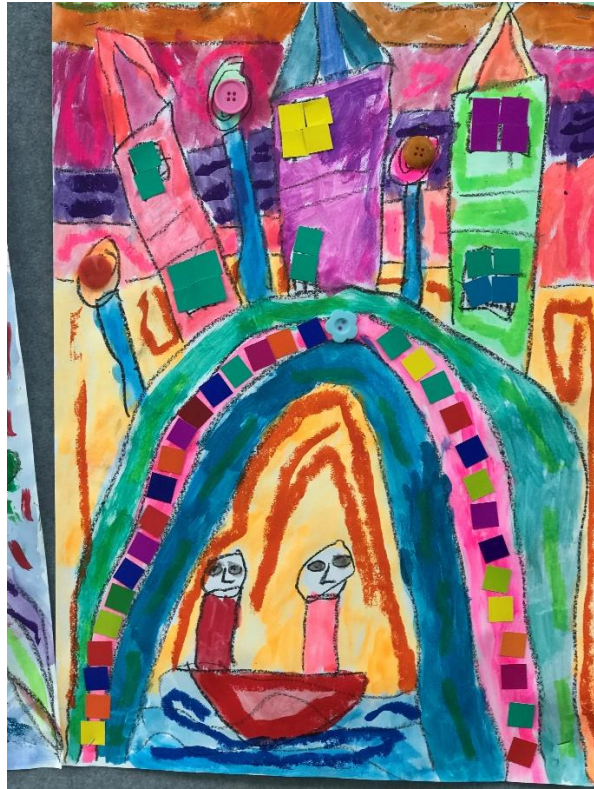


Grade 3 and 4 students designed their own Hundertwasser apartment, featuring onion domes, checks, spirals, uneven lines and lots of colour.



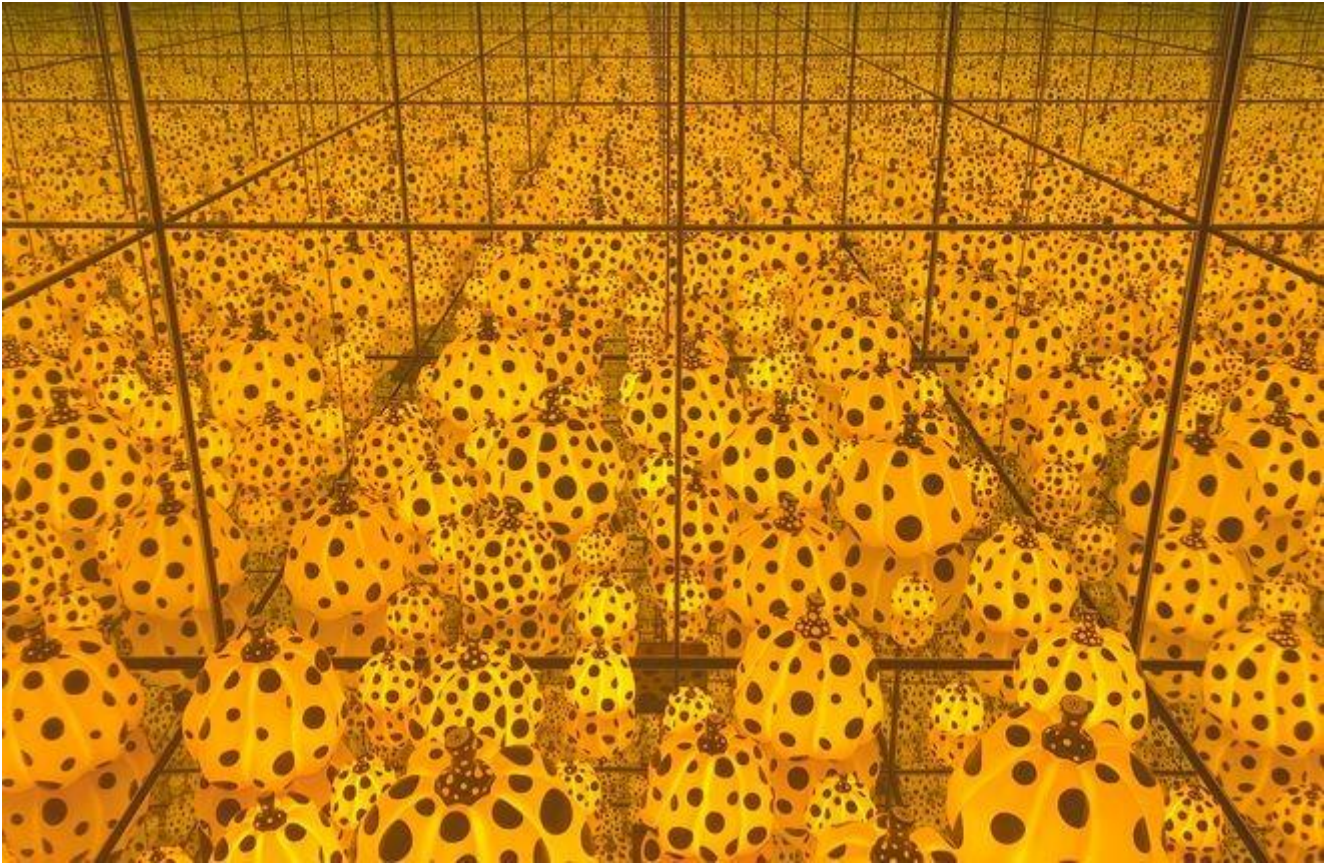
Grade 1 and 2 students created gorgeous work with layers of beautiful bright colour and collage.

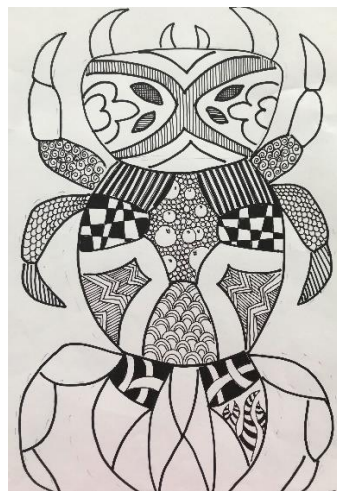
